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SUMMARY

Domestic projects

Generations and gender relations on farms in Slovenia: in 2008, the final report was completed. The results of the survey (n = 817) on the generations and gender relations on farms in Slovenia show that in comparison with non-beneficiaries, subsidy beneficiaries (young successors) are willing to continue with farming, they oppose the equal distribution of agricultural property among the heirs, they live on bigger farms, they also more successfully harmonise various interests of farm household's members, have higher education and fertility, and finally, they expressed greater concern in care giving for their older generation, compared to other observed groups (urban and rural).

Development of quality and accessibility of preventive heath activity on primary level of mental health: Evaluation of 370 mental health services adressed to their availability, utilization and preventive activities, was carried out with Slovenian adaptation of *The European Service Mapping Schedule*.

Evaluation of a psychoeducation and pharmacotherapeutic effects in patients with bipolar mood disorder: Neuropsychological testing of selective attention, behaviour inhibition, social cognition, and clinical scales for mania, depression and impulsivity assessment were applied in the group of healthy volunteers (n = 70) and patients with bipolar mood disorder (n = 60) in order to evaluate the impact of different therapies on cognitive and emotional functioning.

Evaluation of drug prevention programmes in the projects of educational aims for the youth:

The final report of the project was prepared. It contained the analyses of results of five preventive programmes designed for high school pupils. In the evaluation of preventive programmes and services their quality and effects for users were considered. The evaluation was carried out through the interviews with participants and workshops' implementers with two different set of questionnaires.

International projects and cooperation

Electronic standard coding and mapping of services for long-term care (eDESDE-LTC):

Slovenian translation and adaptation of DESDE questionnaire (english version) was accomplished. We composed a list of Slovenian services occupied with long term care for severe physical and intellectual disabilities, mental disorders and elderly with dependency.
