SUMMARY

Since 2000, the interdisciplinary research group at the Sociomedical Institute ZRC SA2U has focused is research interest to phenomena of well-being and metal health. The Institute combines knowledge and research interest objectiongy, anthrepology and medical and health spruholegy. Some of the associates are university professors and gave lectures and lessons at the University of Ljubljana, the University of Nova Gorica and the Postgraduate School ZRC SAZU.

In 2017, the Institute colaborated with numerous partner institutions within the projects of the 7th Framework Programme and Danube Transnational Programme.
