SUMMARY

The Sociomedical Institute combines knowledge and research orientations of sociology, anthropology and medical and health psychology. Broad array of research topics extends from population dynamics (fertility behaviour and migration) and family farming to mental health, stress at the workplace and long-term care.

In the year 2013, researchers completed tasks and works within the Programme (*Language, Memory and Politics of Representation*), three basic research projects (*Community care of the elderly in Slovenia, Developmental strategies of contemporary family farms and Textbooks as Tools for Shaping the Geographical Imagination of Slovenian landscapes*), one target-research project (*Developmental orientations of farms in Slovenia*), two applicative projects within the programme *Health promotion on working place in 2013 and 2014 (Care for the Health of Employees over Focused Management of Psychosocial Loads and with Knowledge to Healthy Employees)* and two international research projects (*Managing Migration and its Effects in SEE – Transnational Actions Towards Evidence Based Strategies and Joint Action 'Mental health and Well-being'*).

In its scientific work, the institute cooperates with several institutions in Slovenia: the University of Ljubljana (the Biotechnical Faculty, the Faculty of Arts, the Faculty of Social Sciences), the University of Maribor, The University of Nova Gorica, social partners (The Association of Free Trade Unions of Slovenia, The Regional organization of ZSSS Podravje and Koroška, Confederation of Public Sector Trade Unions), Glotta Nova, Institute for Productivity, the University Psychiatric Hospital Ljubljana, the General Hospital Novo mesto, the Ministry of labour, family and social affairs, the Ministry of health, the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Food, the Institute for Economic Research and Maribor Development Agency.
